


Interview Pack: Questions

Answers to Questions


Take a note of key quote and phrases. Look out for information that is surprising or new as well as what you might of assumed. Feel free to also visualise the responses by sketching down the persons answers.

TAKE TO PLACE OF INTEREST

What did I see and what did I do?

Write some notes of what you encountered in that space. What surprised you? Where people doing something that interested you? Look for human behaviour. Look for the interactions between people and objects. Describe the environment.
